WHAT WE DO

Community Living Trent Highlands provides a range of services to people living with a developmental disability and their families so that they may enjoy meaningful lives through connection, contribution and choice.

We also support children with special needs, their families and the early learning community.

Through [Job Quest](#), we assist those who face employment barriers to find meaningful long-term employment.



OUR SERVICES

Call us to access these services

Day Nurseries Resource Funding Program provides funding to childcare centres so that they can hire additional staff to support children with special needs in their programs.

Early Learning Resource Program consultants assist children up to 12 years of age who have identified delays in development and are attending/planning to attend a licensed home or centre based program.

Early Learning Quality Initiative (ELQI) promotes professional development and high quality in early learning programs within the City of Kawartha Lakes and County of Haliburton.

Employment Services assist people living with a developmental disability to succeed in the workplace. Support is provided based on individual abilities, interests and goals.

Family Support provide assistance to the families of children and young people who live with a developmental disability.

Job Quest supports people who have a disability or other impairment to find meaningful, long-term employment while assisting employers to find, train and retain reliable, skilled workers. (705) 878-5627

Youth Engagement offers year-round opportunities for young people aged 14 to 21 - regardless of their abilities - to participate in community events, social and leisure activities, and life skills development.

Building Bridges helps young people (17.5 to 21 years of age) living with a developmental disability to plan for the transition from high school to life in their community after graduation.

Community Homes provide accommodation and support to adults with a developmental disability through a 24-hour staffing model, based on an Individual Support Plan.

Community Participation supports people living with a developmental disability to choose daytime activities in their community that are meaningful, enjoyable and consistent with their personal goals.

Foundations helps young people (aged 21 to 28 years) who live with a developmental disability to transition from high school to living on their own.

Life Share offers an alternative to adults with a developmental disability and find it difficult or lonely to live on their own.

Supported Independent Living (SIL) provides personalized support for people with developmental disabilities who are living on their own.
