BUILDING BRIDGES

Pelps young people (17.5 to 21 years of age) living with a developmental disability to plan for the transition from high school to life in their community after graduation.

COMMUNITY HOMES

Provide accommodation and supports to adults with a developmental disability through a 24-hour staffing model, based on an Individual Support Plan.

COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION

Supports people living with a developmental disability to choose daytime activities in their community that are meaningful, enjoyable and consistent with their personal goals.

FOUNDATIONS

Helps young people (aged 21 to 28 years) who live with a developmental disability to transition from high school to living on their own.

LIFE SHARE

A residential option for people living with a developmental disability with the support of other adults in a home setting.

SUPPORTED INDEPENDENT LIVING (SIL)

Provides personalized support for people with developmental disabilities who are living on their own.

EARLY LEARNING RESOURCE

Consultants assist children up to 12 years of age who have identified delays in development and are attending/planning to attend a licensed home or centre based program.

EARLY LEARNING QUALITY INITIATIVE (ELQI)

Promotes professional development and high quality in early learning programs within the City of Kawartha Lakes and County of Haliburton.

EMPLOYMENT SUPPORTS

Assist people living with a developmental disability to succeed in the workplace. Support is provided based on individual abilities, interests and goals.

FAMILY SUPPORT


Provide assistance to the families of children and young people who live with a developmental disability.

Offers year-round opportunities for young people aged 14 to 21 regardless of their abilities - to participate in community events, social and leisure activities, and life skills development.




